

“100 Verses That Everyone Should Know”

Beginnings: The Bible's Fantastic Four

1. Genesis 1:1 — In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.
2. John 1:1 — In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
3. John 1:14 — The Word became flesh and made His dwelling among us. We have seen His glory, the glory of the One and Only, full of grace and truth.
4. John 3:16 — For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life.

The Roman Road: The Plan of Salvation

5. Romans 3:23 — For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God.
6. Romans 6:23 — For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
7. Romans 5:8 — But God demonstrates His own love for us in this; While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
8. Romans 10:9 — That if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.
9. Romans 10:10 — For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved.

Listening: The Word of God and Prayer

10. 2 Timothy 3:16 — All Scripture is God breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness.
11. Joshua 1:8 — Do not let this Book of the Law depart from your mouth; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful.
12. Psalms 119:11 — I have hidden Your word in my heart that I might not sin against You.
13. Deuteronomy 6:6 — These commandments that I give you today are to be upon your hearts.
14. Deuteronomy 6:7 — Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up.
15. Hebrews 4:12 — For the word of God is living and active. Sharper than any double — edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.
16. Hebrews 4:16 — Let us then approach the throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.
17. 1 John 5:14 — This is the confidence we have in approaching God: that if we ask anything according to his will, he hears us.
18. 1 John 5:15 — And if we know that He hears us — whatever we ask — we know that we have whatever we ask of Him.

Assurance: Inner Peace & Security

19. 1 John 5:11 — And this is the testimony: God has given us eternal life, and this life is in his Son.
20. 1 John 5:12 — He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life.
21. John 14:1 — Do not let your hearts be troubled. Trust in God; trust also in Me.

22. John 14:2 — In My Father's house are many rooms; if it were not so, I would have told you. I am going there to prepare a place for you.
23. John 14:3 — And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come back and take you to be with Me that you also may be where I am.
24. John 14:6 — Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.
25. John 14:27 — Peace I leave with you; My peace I give to you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid.
26. Isaiah 26:3 — You will keep in perfect peace him whose mind is steadfast, because he trusts in you.
27. Isaiah 53:5— But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon him, and by his wounds we are healed.
28. Isaiah 53:6— We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to his own way; and the LORD has laid on him the iniquity of us all.

Praise: Worship & Thanksgiving

29. 1 Peter 1:3 — Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! In his great mercy he has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead.
30. Psalms 100:4 — Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise; give thanks to him and praise his name.
31. Psalms 100:5 —For the LORD is good and his love endures forever; his faithfulness continues through all generations.
32. Revelation 4:11 — You are worthy, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, for you created all things, and by your will they were created and have their being.

Promises

33. Matthew 6:33 — But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.
34. Romans 8:28 — And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.
35. Jeremiah 29:11 — For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.
36. 1 John 1:7 — But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin.
37. 1 John 1:9 — If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.
38. Proverbs 3:5 — Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding.
39. Proverbs 3:6 —In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He will make your paths straight.
40. 1 Corinthians 10:13 — No temptation has seized you except what is common to man. And God is faithful; He will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, he will also provide a way out so that you can stand up under it.
41. Psalms 55:22 — Cast your cares on the Lord and He will sustain you; He will never let the righteous fall.
42. 1 Peter 5:7 — Cast all your anxiety on Him because He cares for you.

Holiness: Obeying God's Commands

43. 2 Chronicles 7:14 — If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and will heal their land.
44. Romans 12:1 — Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God — this is your spiritual act of worship.
45. Romans 12:2 — Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is — His good, pleasing and perfect will.
46. Romans 12:11 — Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord.
47. Romans 12:12 — Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer.
48. Romans 12:18 — If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone.
49. 2 Corinthians 9:7 — Each man should give what he has decided in his heart to give, not reluctantly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver.
50. Hebrews 10:25 — Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.
51. Proverbs 1:7 — The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge, but fools despise wisdom and discipline.
52. Proverbs 15:1 — A gentle answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger.

Fullness: The Holy Spirit's Role in our Lives

53. Ephesians 5:18 — Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery. Instead, be filled with the Spirit.
54. Ephesians 5:19 — Speak to one another with psalms, hymns and spiritual songs. Sing and make music in your heart to the Lord.\
55. Ephesians 5:20 — Always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.
56. Ephesians 5:21 — Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ.
57. Galatians 5:22 — But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness...
58. Galatians 5:23 — ... gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.

Joy

59. Psalm 118:24 — This is the day the LORD has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it.
60. Phil. 4:4 — Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say it again: Rejoice!
61. Phil. 4:5 — Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near.
62. Phil. 4:6 — Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God.
63. Phil. 4:7 — And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.
64. James 1:2 — Consider it pure joy, my brothers, whenever you face trials of many kinds.
65. James 1:3 — Because you know that the testing of your faith develops perseverance.

66. James 1:4 — Perseverance must finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything.
67. James 1:5 — If any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to him.
68. 1 Thessalonians 5:16 — Be joyful always.
69. 1 Thessalonians 5:17 — Pray continually.
70. 1 Thessalonians 5:18 — Give thanks in all circumstances, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

Faith: Trusting God & Resting in His Word

71. Ephesians 2:8 — For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith — and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God.
72. Ephesians 2:9 — Not by works, so that no one can boast.
73. Ephesians 2:10 — For we are God's workmanship, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do.
74. Galatians 2:20 — I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.
75. Colossians 3:15 — Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful.
76. Colossians 3:16 — Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom, and as you sing psalms, hymns and spiritual songs with gratitude in your hearts to God.
77. Colossians 3:17 — And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him.
78. Romans 1:16 — I am not ashamed of the gospel, because it is the power of God for the salvation of everyone who believes: first for the Jew, then for the Gentile.
79. Romans 1:17 — For in the gospel a righteousness from God is revealed, a righteousness that is by faith from first to last, just as it is written: "The righteous will live by faith."
80. Psalms 56:3 — When I am afraid, I will trust in you.
81. Psalms 4:8 — I will lie down and sleep in peace, for you alone, O Lord, make me dwell in safety.
82. Hebrews 11:6 — And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to Him must believe that He exists and that He rewards those who earnestly seek Him.

83. Matthew 28:18 — Then Jesus came to them and said, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me."
84. Matthew 28:19 — Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.
85. Matthew 28:20 — And teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age."
86. Acts 1:8 — But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be My witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.

The Twenty-third Psalm

87. Psalm 23:1 — The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not be in want.

88. Psalm 23:2 — He makes me lie down in green pastures, He leads me beside quiet waters.
89. Psalm 23:3 — He restores my soul. He guides me in paths of righteousness for His name's sake.
90. Psalm 23:4 — Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me.
91. Psalm 23:5 — You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. You anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows.
92. Psalm 23:6 — Surely goodness and love will follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever.

Alpha & Omega: The First & Second Comings of Christ

93. Isaiah 9:6 — For to us a child is born, to us a son is given, and the government will be on his shoulders. And he will be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace.
94. Luke 2:10 — But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news of great joy that will be for all the people."
95. Luke 2:11 — Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; He is Christ the Lord.
96. Luke 2:12 — This will be a sign to you: You will find a baby wrapped in cloths and lying in a manger.
97. Acts 1:11 — "Men of Galilee," they said, "why do you stand here looking into the sky? This same Jesus, who has been taken from you into heaven, will come back in the same way you have seen him go into heaven."
98. Revelation 21:1 — Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and there was no longer any sea.
99. Revelation 21:2 — I saw the Holy City, the new Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God, prepared as a bride beautifully dressed for her husband.
100. Revelation 22:20 — He who testifies to these things says, "Yes, I am coming soon." Amen. Come, Lord Jesus.
